

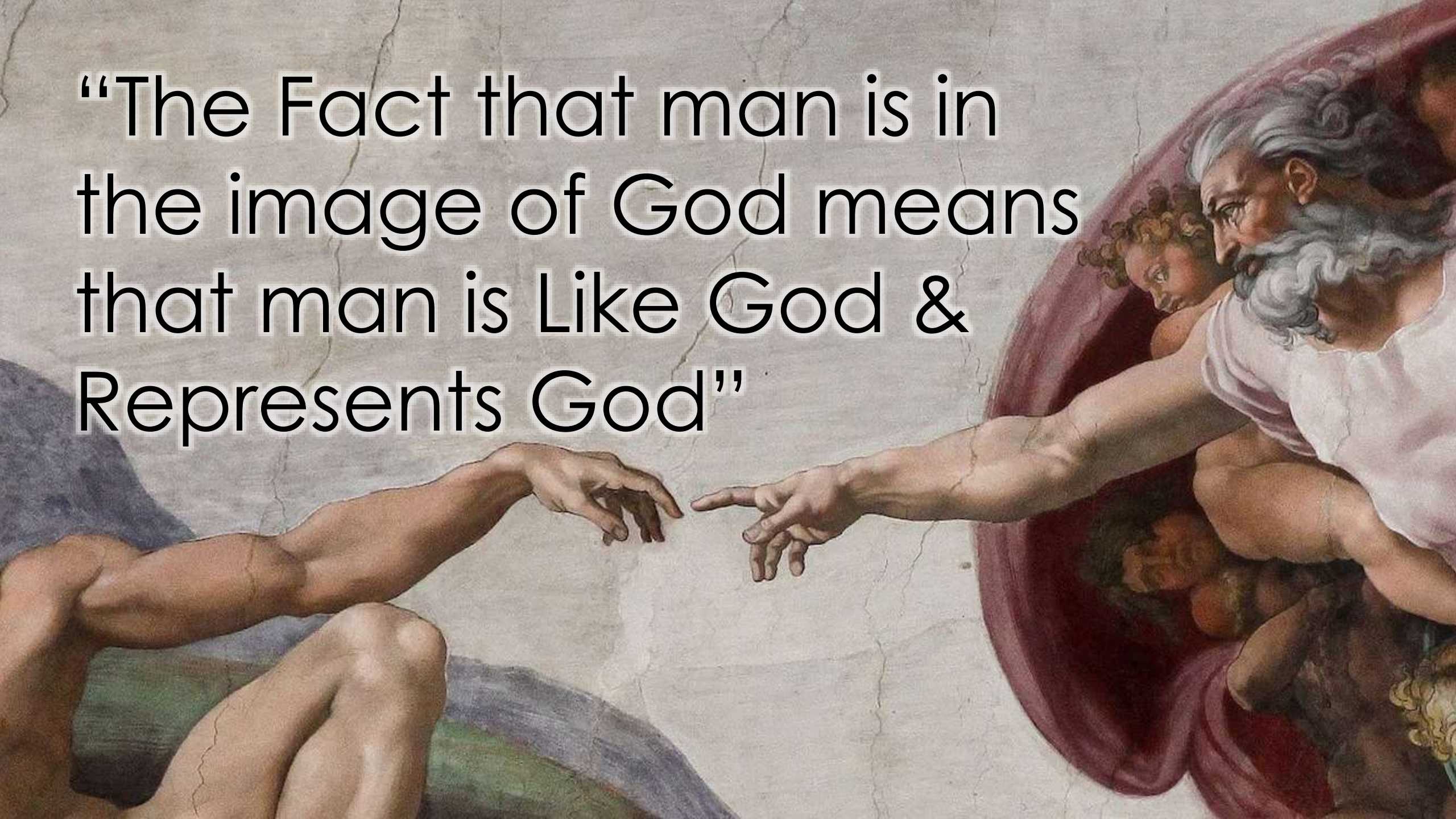

“The Fact that man is in the image of God means that man is Like God & Represents God”



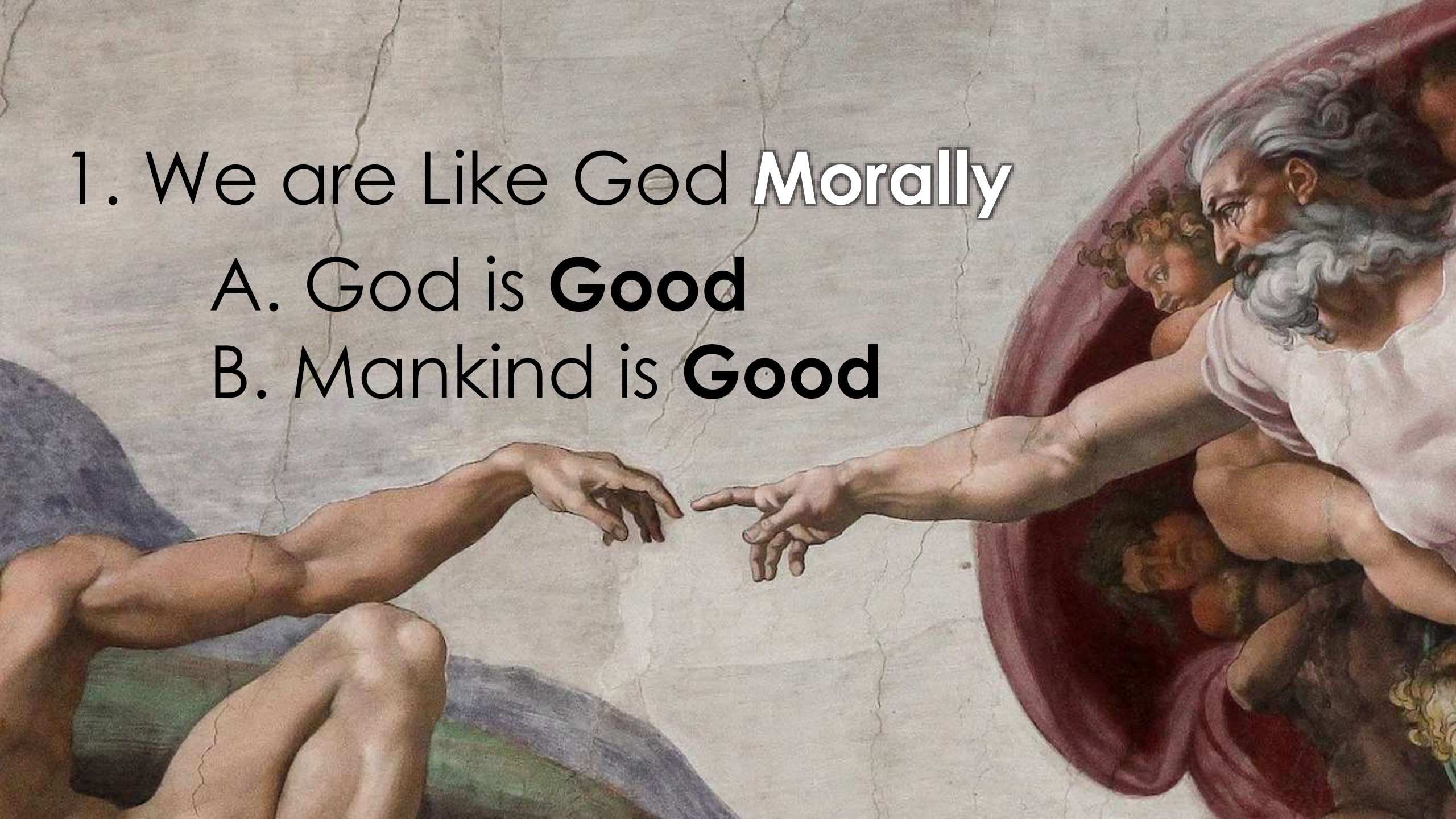
How are We Like God?
